**MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:**

- **CLC YMCA CDBG Grant Opportunity- Sally Farrell-Child Care Director- *They are applying for a grant that the town would need to approve and distribute. Mary Ellen Barnes will be working with us again to help us thru this process. A letter of commitment needs to be signed by the Selectmen and submitted by March 26, 2021. This is the first step for CLC YMCA to apply. Mary Ellen would like to attend our next Selectmen's meeting March 24<sup>th</sup> along with Sally to explain and to have the Selectmen sign the Letter of Intent.*** The selectmen would like to discuss the purpose of the Grant.
- **Road Sign Mills? Dale would like to know if Selectmen would like "No Parking on Sidewalks" taken down or replaced between Mills Fire Station & George Weston? There are currently 2 signs up, but the "No Parking" portion of the sign has faded and no longer visible. Dale would like input as we should buy new ones.** The Selectmen feel we need to reorder the signs for the Mills.
- **Sue:** *There was a new resident that moved into the Mills and questioned if we were going to put in speed bumps for the summer or other measurers to slow traffic down. I explained to him we met 2 years ago on this and it is an ongoing discussion and one he should have with the locals in the Mills. I explained the people there did not want the speed bumps because of the noise, we have signs there and we use the mobile speed sign. I explained I would be happy to look up the minutes from that meeting and give it to him. But ultimately, he needs to talk to his neighbors.*

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Dick would like to make a motion for a policy for the Fire Dept to give the Selectmen the invoices and/or POs for purchases over \$1000.00 for approval. Richard P -motion to require the FD to submit PO's and Invoices to the Selectmen for approval before buying anything. Jon second Motion, all in favor, no further discussion, so moved. Dick will call and talk to Richard about this.
