- **Richard Genthner-Approval to purchase items for FD.** *This bill is for Nobleboro Fire & Rescue Pro Packs. Selectmen agreed to and have amended the Warrant including this bill.*
- **Bob Barkelow- Fish Ladder update and scheduled events-** *Bob & David came in to share the plans for the Fish Ladder. They will be doing a 5K on May 20<sup>th</sup> (Memorial Day Weekend) Bayview Road will be closed down and Belvedere will be subject to One Lane traffic. Bob gave a map of the proposed road plan. They contacted LC Sheriff to set this up. Jon- suggested they contact the Fire Chief of this plan especially about the road closure and one way traffic. Richard P will get the speed sign down there for the event. Bob said they may be serving Ice Cream and Hot dogs as well as selling merchandise that day. The Committee decided there will not be a festival this year. Richard- he wanted express concern about leaving merchandise in the fish house during selling the alewives. Bob & David assured him they do not leave anything in there to be concerned about. Richard also expressed concern about the parking down there and people backing out into traffic by the fish house and the corner. David- question trimming back by the corner? Richard explained they were going to do it but there was concern about having it cut back too much. David-I guess I was too concerned then as it was an unnecessary concern.*
- **Appoint Michael Johnson to Planning Board—** *Richard-motion to appoint Michael Johnson to the Planning Board, Jon second the motion, no further discussion, all in favor, so moved.*
- **Mary Sheldon-Historical Society-Gutters for building.
