

**Select board Meeting Agenda

June 7, 2023 @ 6:00 pm**

OPEN MEETING: Spear opened the meeting at 6:00pm.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Benner brought up about a spot on the West Neck Road that has quite a dip and asked, if there is anything left in the hot topping budget, if he could then shim that part of West Neck Road instead of ditching. Select Board agreed to that if there was enough leftover in budget to do so.

On motion Powell/Chadwick moved to approve. Vote 3-0

MINUTES: Approve 5/24 meeting minutes: **On motion Powell/Chadwick moved to approve the May 24th meeting minutes. Vote 3-0**

SCHOOL & TOWN WARRANTS:

1. Town Payroll Warrant #46: \$13,545.15.

Discussion ensued about the balance and tax bills were mentioned. Spear spoke about the tax bills being sent out and then money then will be coming in. Spear and Emerald spoke, and Tax bills will be done June 9th. Spear also directed Robyn to move \$50,000 from line of credit to main checking account.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. MDOT Bridget Report – Duck Puddle bridge
Chadwick mentioned that there was an email that this was flagged as a problem. Spear said that there was nothing that we could directly do about it being that it is half Waldoboro's. Spear also mentioned that it needs to be joint repair between the 2 towns. Jon had spoken with Max from Waldoboro and Max proposed to get a grant. Spear said that this would need to be put in the long-term plan to be fixed.
2. Set Mil Rate – Sign Municipal Valuation Report
**Spear mentioned that he spoke with Frank, our Assessor and that they felt that 13.7 mil rate for 2023 would be good. Powell said that it was just under 7% increase.
On Motion Powell/Chadwick moved to approve the 2023 mil rate. Vote 3-0**

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

1. July 3rd – Town Office Holiday Hours

Emerald suggested closing the office July 3rd since July 4th is on a Tuesday but then be open either 5/30 or 7/7. Jon had said that sounded like it would be good and that being open July 7th full day would be better than 5/30. Emerald said that it would be advertised in the newspaper, website and posted at the town office.

On Motion Chadwick/Powell moved to approve July 3rd closed and open full day July 7th
Vote 3-0.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Selectboard all said and agreed that Benner did a great job ditching. Powell asked about the sand and salt shed door. Cameron has sent an email and deposit has been sent and have not heard any further.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chadwick asked if we can get law enforcement involved with the truck traffic on back meadow road. Benner mentioned that we have the signs up but that it was not put through a special town meeting. Spear had said that Chadwick could call Lincoln County and see what they could do.
