GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Nobleboro, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Nobleboro Central School at 6:00 pm on Tuesday the 4th day of October A.D. 2022 to act on the following articles to wit:

Emerald read Article 1 To choose, by written ballot, a moderator to preside at said meeting- Dick Spear motion to nominate Don Means as Moderator. Counted vote of 36 for Don Means and 1 for Richard Spear.

Don was sworn in by Emerald Friend, Town Clerk

Don read-Article 2 To see if the Town will vote to approve the town's new revised Comprehensive Plan, Selectboard & Comprehensive Plan Committee Recommends

Motion to approve Article 2, any discussion, no discussion, All in favor, no opposed, Article 2 passes

Don read -Article 3 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate Funds from Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA) received by the Town from the Federal government for the projects listed below, said appropriation to be non-lapsing and to remain legally effective until all of said projects have been completed. Projects are: Nobleboro Fire & Rescue aka Nobleboro Fire Department Equipment, Fire Department Building Maintenance, Infrastructure of culverts and storm drains.

Selectboard Recommends

Motion to approve Article 3, any discussion,

*Questions asked about the amount left in ARPA money roughly \$79,000- Dick agreed

*Money given to Broadband- Dick explained \$57,500 was appropriated to them.

*Any of this money going to Minnehatta- Per Dick Spear-No that is not part of these articles.

Aaron Bradbury told resident they could talk with him about Minnehatta.

*Storm & Erosion Drainage & Infrastructure- can some of the money go toward Bayview Rd- Dick- yes it can.

* Can more money go towards these if there is a need in the future-Dick explained yes it can if it meets the ARPA Funds criteria
